

This primary number game is adapted from *Playing with Math...The Name of the Game*, Chris' Game.

Primary Number Game

Materials:

- * Number cards (0-99) on one color paper
- * Action cards on a different color of paper

Rules:

1. Shuffle the number cards and place face down.
2. Shuffle the action cards and place in a separate pile face down.
3. Each player in turn draws one numeral card and one action card. Player reads the action card and responds with a number answer based on the action. If the answer is correct, the player keeps their number card and returns the action card to the bottom of the action card pile. If the answer is incorrect, the player places their number card at the bottom of the number card stack.
4. The game ends when the number card deck is gone.
5. The player with the most number cards wins.

Players may need a tool such as a hundreds chart to play.
